

Key Projects

- Maxwell AFB: Burn Building Renovation Power wash and paint exterior metal building, replace exiting roof with standing seam roof, repair concrete surfaces and install training maze for fire fighters.
- **JBSA Randolph: File System Removal** Demolish existing movable filing system and remove VCT floor and abatement of asbestos.
- National Parks: Asphalt Walk Replacement Removed 13,000 LF of asphalt walking path and replace with new asphalt materials.
